- Collaborate closely with Maine Medical Center's specialty pharmacy program to provide seamless medication access and care management.

- Pharm.D. from an accredited College of Pharmacy and pharmacist licensure eligibility to practice in the State of Maine.
- PGY1 Pharmacy residency required.
- PGY2 in Infectious Diseases strongly preferred.
