Candidates with training, added qualifications, or equivalent experience in adult infectious diseases pharmacy practice are highly encouraged to apply. Applications should include a letter of intent, curriculum vitae, a statement of teaching philosophy, a statement of scholarship philosophy, and the names, addresses, phone numbers and e-mail addresses of three professional references.
