Antimicrobial Stewardship Clinical Pharmacist provides comprehensive, cost effective, medication-related care for the purpose of achieving outcomes that improve patient's quality of life. The incumbent acts in collaboration with physicians and other health care professionals in the responsibility for patient drug therapy outcomes with a focus on antimicrobial management. Secondary functions include, but are not limited to, tracking and reporting utilization of antibiotics and resistance patterns, assisting with publication of hospital antibiogram, education of providers and other pharmacy staff, participation in antimicrobial stewardship committee and other initiatives, and serving as a preceptor for residents and students. Practice setting – inpatient hospital pharmacy.

Education: Pharmacy degree from an accredited School of pharmacy required.

Minimum Experience Requirements: Completion of an ASHP accredited PGY1 pharmacy residency required. Completion of a PGY2 residency in Infectious Disease preferred.
