

Clinical Assistant Professor – Infectious Disease

Department of Pharmacotherapy and Translational Research

The Department of Pharmacotherapy and Translational Research invites applications for a full-time, 12-month, non-tenure track position at the rank of Clinical Assistant Professor. The successful candidate will contribute to a partnership in which College of Pharmacy faculty share responsibilities for clinical practice in UF Health Shands Hospital and contribute to the teaching mission of the College. The successful candidate will be responsible for clinical practice; teaching; service to the College of Pharmacy, Hospital, and the pharmacy profession; and scholarly activity. Faculty in these positions report to the Chair of the Department of Pharmacotherapy and Translational Research with clinical reporting responsibility to the Director of Pharmacy (or designee) in the UF Health Shands Department of Pharmacy.

The successful candidate will be responsible for participating in direct patient care activities with the Antimicrobial Stewardship Team, ensuring and enforcing compliance with established clinical protocols, and identifying and implementing programs that ensure cost effective use of antimicrobials. Minimum Requirements: The applicant should have a PharmD degree with 2 years of post-graduate training (residency, fellowship or equivalent experience). Florida licensure is required. Excellent teaching and communication skills are essential. FDLE Criminal Background Check Required.

Preferred Qualifications: Board certification, previous teaching experience, demonstrated scholarship, and experience in mentoring students and/or residents is preferred. Successful completion of a PGY2 Infectious Disease Residency or ID fellowship is preferred. Applicants with equivalent experience in infectious diseases and antimicrobial stewardship will be considered.

The Search Committee will accept applications until the position is filled. Applications will be reviewed starting April 5, 2019. Interested applicants should submit an online application that includes a cover letter briefly summarizing your accomplishments, scholarly interests, and teaching philosophy, curriculum vitae, and the names of three individuals willing to serve as professional references. Three letters of recommendation will be required if selected for the position.
