



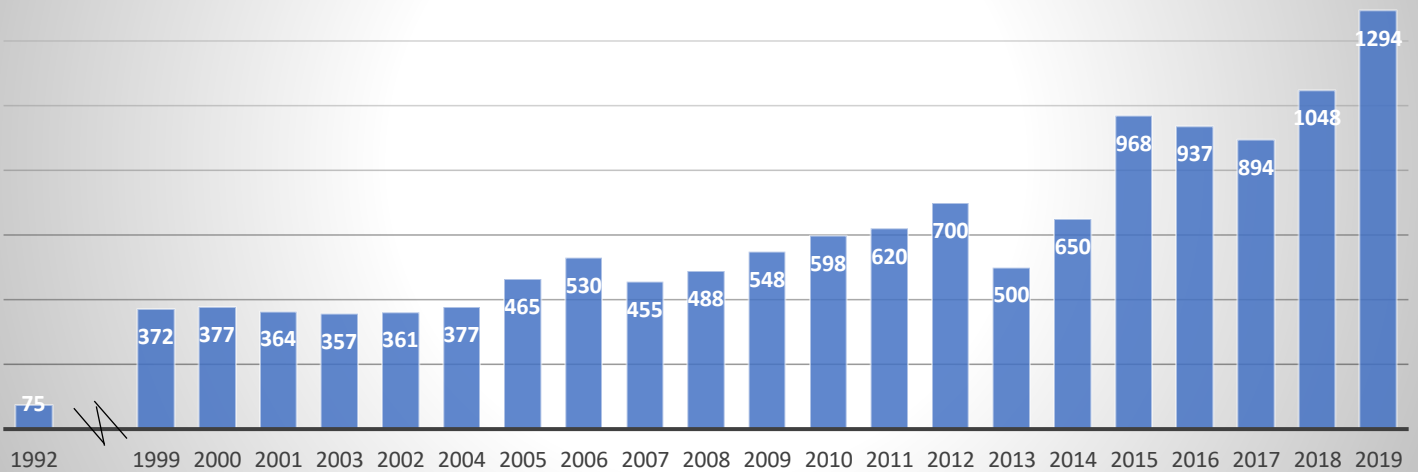

In celebration of 30 years of SIDP, the annual report committee wanted to highlight the growth of the organization over the past 3 decades. Whether it is in the increasing membership over the years or the changing practice, SIDP continues to evolve. Please join us in celebrating this evolution by reviewing a few select areas of this growth below.

SIDP Membership

In 1992, there were approximately 75 members and by the time the first edition of our yearly Society report was published in 1999 this number had increased to 372. There was a slow steady growth in the number of members through the 2000s. When Antimicrobial Stewardship officially became a Joint Commission standard in 2017, the number significantly increased as more pharmacists completed SIDP's Stewardship certificate and began stewardship practices. As of 2021 we have almost 1500 members.

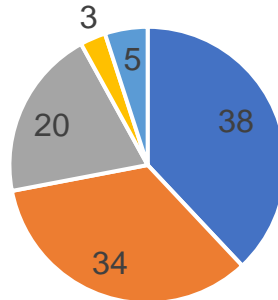
SIDP Membership 1992 to 2019



Evolving Practice Sites

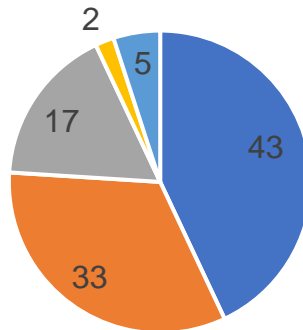
Practice sites for our members have also changed over the past 30 years. In 1999, the first Annual Report listed 38% of members as working primarily in academia and 34% in hospital or clinic environment. By 2007, those numbers were 33% and 43%, respectively. In 2017, the last year we summarized these data, 72% of our members worked in hospital/clinic compared to only 14% in academia. Working in industry decreased from 20% in 1999 to 6% in 2017.

Practice Site 1999



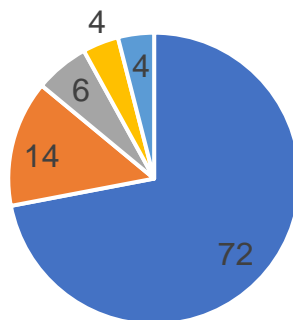
■ Hospital/clinic ■ Academia ■ Industry ■ Government ■ Other

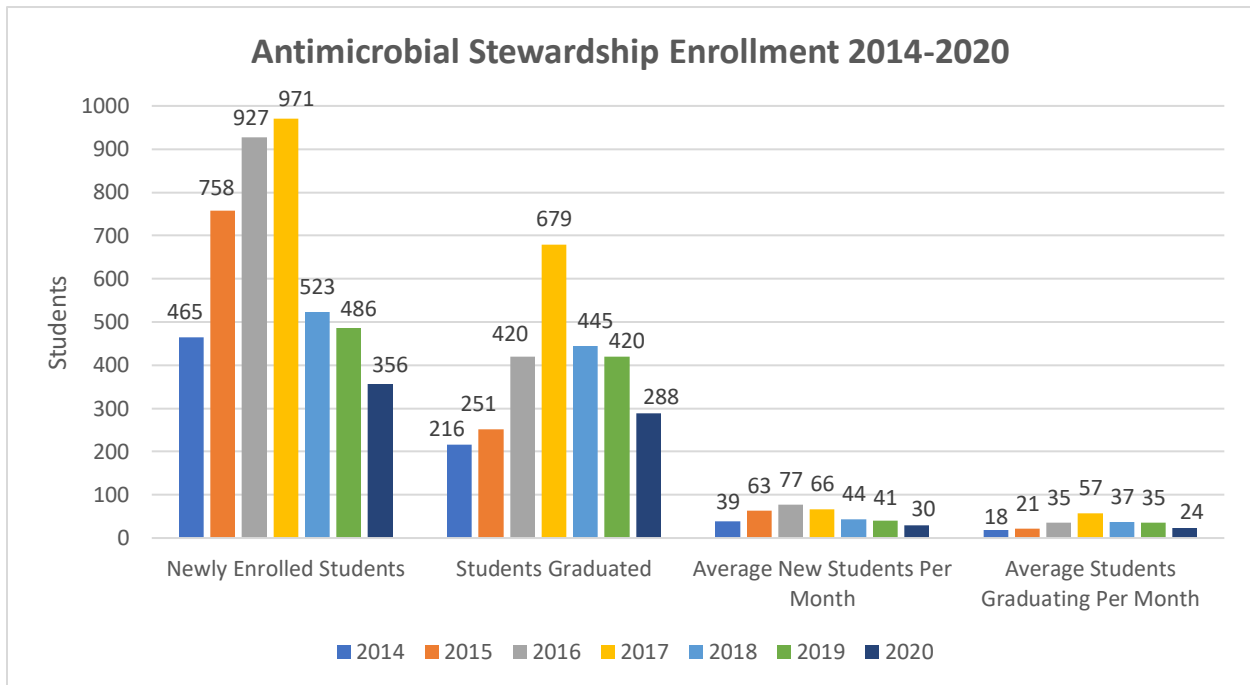
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Growth of Committees

SIDP committees were first developed in January 1992. Six committees were formed and charged with various functions within the society: Program Committee, Research Committee, Election Committee, Finance Committee, Publications Committee, and the Membership Committee. Over the years, additional committees have been added to address the growth of the organization. As of 2020, SIDP has 20 committees which consists of a Chair, Vice-Chair, one to two Board Liaisons, and several members.

SIDP Antimicrobial Stewardship Certificate

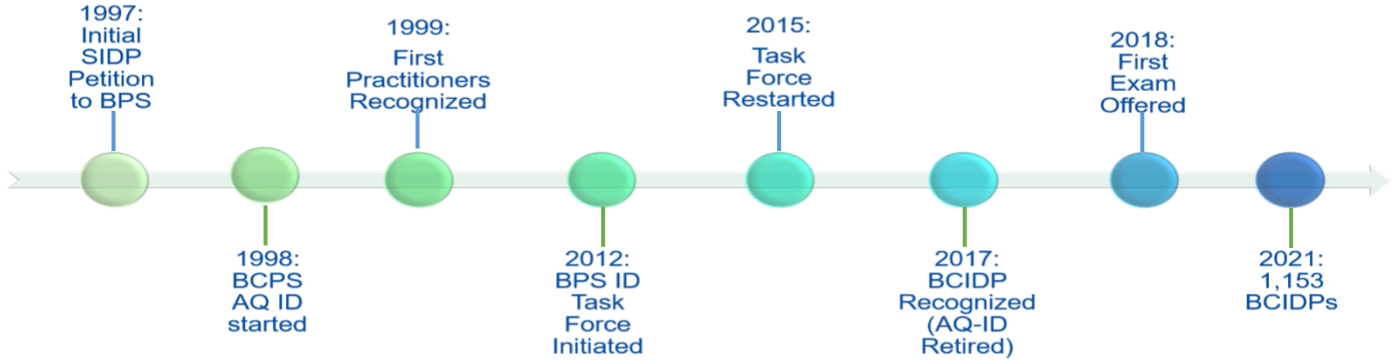
The Antimicrobial Stewardship Certificate Training Program, implemented in 2010, is designed to promote development of pharmacists practicing antimicrobial stewardship and provide them the expertise to successfully implement an antimicrobial stewardship program. Below is the enrollment from 2014 when ProCE took over data aggregation until 2020. Since that time there have been 2,659 students graduate from the certification program with an additional 593 graduating prior to 2013.
