

We are looking for an advanced clinical pharmacist in Infectious Diseases to join our team. The Advanced Pharmacist-Infectious Diseases at Via Christi will coordinate with other healthcare professionals to provide comprehensive, evidence-based antimicrobial treatment to improve patient outcomes. Via Christi has been active in Antimicrobial Stewardship efforts for over 20 years and is progressive, including components such as: a pharmacist-directed penicillin skin testing program, use of rapid diagnostics, and a clinical decision support tool to enhance selection of patients for stewardship activities. This pharmacist will have opportunities to collaborate with other infectious diseases pharmacists and physicians across the country as part of Ascension Health. The pharmacist will work closely with the ID medical director, microbiology department, infection prevention and control practitioners, and the quality department to guide appropriate antimicrobial utilization, both formally and informally, through the antibiotic subcommittee of the pharmacy and therapeutics committee. In addition, this person will track and report antibiotic utilization, compile data to measure program results, develop and publish the organization's antibiogram and educate providers. Participation in the multi-disciplinary stewardship program to maximize patient safety, consulting on therapeutic regimens, and developing protocols will be performed to ensure optimal drug therapy in all situations. The pharmacist will work in conjunction with the medical staff and the team of pharmacists to continue to develop and improve clinical pharmacy practice through daily patient care and the implementation of innovative clinical pharmacy services. The individual will be expected to participate in the professional development of healthcare providers including pharmacists, pharmacy residents, physicians, medical residents, medical students, and nursing personnel. Opportunities exist for faculty appointment, and to conduct and publish clinical research. The individual will be responsible for mentoring and precepting pharmacy students and PGY1 pharmacy residents.

The candidate must have a PharmD and advanced training (i.e. residency, fellowship, and/or board certification) or extensive equivalent experience. Infectious Diseases specialty residency and experience are strongly preferred. Licensure in the State of Kansas (or eligibility) is required.

A generous compensation package, including full benefits is included for the successful candidate. The position is in Wichita Kansas which boasts a very reasonable cost of living, numerous forms of local entertainment, and proximity to many other regional areas of interest.
