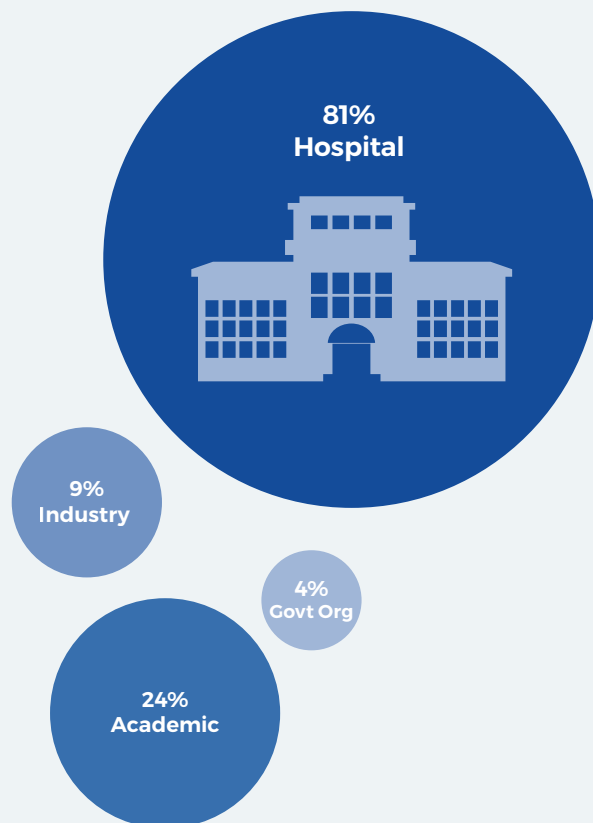

Distribution of SIDP Member Practice Settings



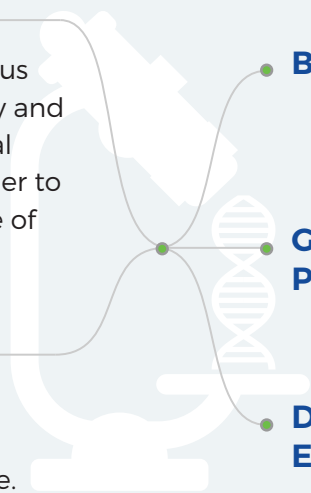

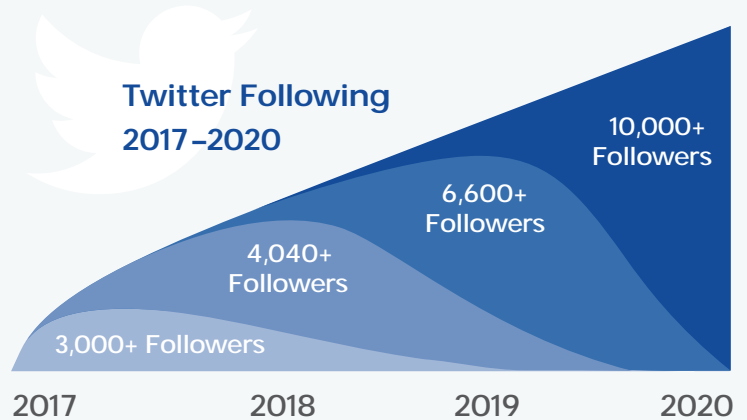

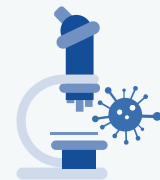
Stewards

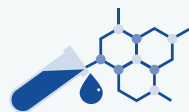
Educators
