Requests for funding (500 word maximum) should include the following information:

1. Describe your project or event and how it relates to SIDP's mission, vision, and core values.
2. Describe expected project outcomes.
3. Provide a detailed budget for the requested funds
  - a. Individual budget request cannot exceed \$2500
  - b. Budget should detail how funds will be used
  - c. In the event of multiple requests that exceed what SIDP can support that year, priority will be given to organizations/events who have not received funding support from SIDP previously

Grants will be awarded twice annually. **Applications for the first cycle will be accepted from January 18-February 26, 2021** and awardees will be notified by March 15, 2021. **Applications for the second cycle will be accepted from June 1-June 30, 2021** and awardees will be notified by July 19, 2021.
