Proposed programs are encouraged to be multidisciplinary, provide public education, and/or support novel training mechanisms for healthcare professionals. Involvement of a pharmacist is encouraged in design and/or target audience. Programs that generate educational content that will be made free and publicly available will be scored favorably. This grant is not intended to fund stewardship research projects with an individual hospital or healthcare system.

Examples of previously funded proposals:

- Sponsorship of SIDP member keynote speaker at Alabama Infectious Diseases Society Conference
- Establishment of a regional urinary antibiogram to optimize treatment of urinary tract infections
- Creation of statewide antimicrobial stewardship training modules for high school students (content will be modifiable for general use across any state)
- Development of virtual microbiology lab "tour" via a series of educational videos (content will be shared on SIDP YouTube account)
- Community pharmacy Antibiotic Take Back Day
- Informational Video on Infectious Diseases Pharmacists for Undergraduate and Pharmacy Students

Required grant sections (500 words max):

- A. Description of project or event
- B. Description of expected deliverables from the proposal
- C. Description of expected audience characteristics and size
- D. Detailed budget and justification for the requested funds
 - a. Budgets cannot exceed \$2500
 - b. Institutional Overhead is not permitted

Awards will be awarded twice annually. Applications for the first cycle will be accepted from January 16-February 24, 2023 and awardees will be notified by March 17, 2023. Applications for the second cycle will be accepted from June 5-June 30, 2023 and awardees will be notified by July 21, 2023. Requests can be sent to treasurer@sidp.org and will be reviewed by the Board as received.
