Minimum Qualifications

PharmD, CPR/BLS, and a minimum of 2 years of experience as a clinical pharmacist. Incumbent must obtain HIV specialty Pharmacist (AAHIVM) within 60 days. The university offers market competitive salary and benefits. Grade EJ

Preferred Qualifications

The preferred candidate will have previous experience working with patients with HIV/AIDS. The candidate would be expected to pursue certification as an HIV Specialty Pharmacist (AAHIVM).

Position Description

The Division of Infectious Diseases is seeking a Specialty Pharmacist whose primary role will be providing HIV treatment regimen education and adherence counseling to Ryan White HIV program patients at the 550 clinic. This includes performing medication reconciliation services for patients; working with providers, case managers, and ancillary staff as a member of the multidisciplinary team in order to provide holistic medical care for patients; ensuring patient access to medication through processing prior authorization applications and co-payment assistance programs and interactions with specialty pharmacies including KADAP; performing medication dispensing procedures including: sterile compounding, compounding, unit dose dispensing, and order entry; and participating in clinical quality management activities as assigned. This position may also require supervision of pharmacy students and residents. Other duties as assigned.
